The programme aims for interested Mentees (graduates or doctoral candidates) at African Universities and research institutes who are looking for advice on how to advance their studies and/or scientific career. With the support of Mentors, Mentees are given the opportunity to shape their career path through international networking, gain knowledge and experience while enhancing their personal and professional skills in order to define and realize their career goals.

Additionally, we are looking for junior scientists, PhDs and Postdocs at MPIs who are interested in a scientific exchange with graduates, doctorates and junior researchers in African countries and the African cultural environment

What we offer

- A one-year collaboration for 25 Mentor-Mentee-pairs.
- A 4-week-stay of the Mentees at the MPIs of the menters.
- Provision of accommodation and reimbursement of visa, travel and insurance cost during the 4 week stay
- An avenue for cultural enrichment and networking among peers

- Proof of enrolment for Mentees
- Willingness to take up new tasks and challenges
- International passport (with a minimum of 6 months validity) or a valid means of identification
